

FH Pyxis[™] ES Automated Dispensing Cabinets [ADCs] Faculty and Student User Access Request Information

Pyxis[™] MedStations[™] secure 90% of the medications in a patient care area. Only approved students and instructors may have access to and remove medications from ADCs. Site Clinical Nurse Advisors (CNAs) or Pyxis[™] Administrators provide access.

What do I need to know?

- Instructors and students require a **FHA Windows Login Username** and BioID fingerprint registration in order to access Pyxis™
- Please review <u>Faculty and Student Privilege Levels</u> for permissions and limitations related to medication administration practices
- All student/instructor information and user access request forms are found on the <u>Fraser Health public webpage</u>

How do I request access?

- Send user access requests/changes/cancellations to the site specific mailbox no less than 7 days prior to the rotation start date. (*Access exemptions:* Please see Appendix B)
 - CNAs will <u>only accept</u> user access request form from program/placement coordinators and/or clinical instructors

What are access and training requirements?

- Clinical Instructors and Preceptorships students require <u>Pyxis[™] Basic Training</u> (#19194)
 Exception: If an instructor or preceptee has completed training as an employee, CNA(s) will send information regarding their separate access
- **Clinical student groups** are required to complete the <u>Pyxis ES Module</u> (#32834) (Including *specialty education programs, Respiratory Therapy*) in order to obtain access. Access and BioID fingerprint registration will be provided onsite with instructors or as instructed by CNAs/Pyxis Administrators


What are the responsibilities of a Clinical Instructor?

- Registering their own students on the cabinet
- Leading the orientation as they best know the students' learning needs
 - The intention is to go through basic functions/how you're going to work together on the unit related to medication administration practices. Connect with site CNA(s) for topics to cover
- Book the training room for minimum 1 hour through the site CNA(s)
