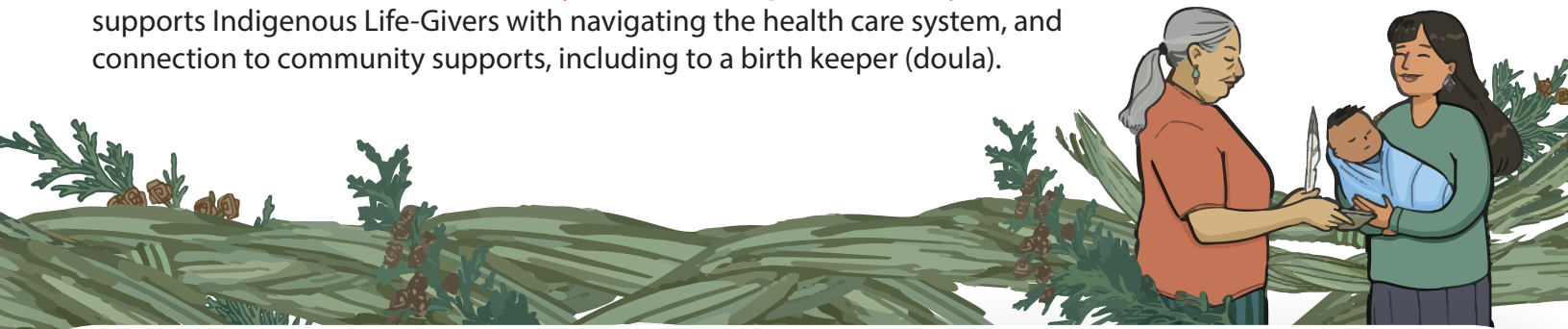


# Bringing Indigenous culture to your birth experience

The Indigenous Maternal Liaison (IML) position promotes culturally appropriate birthing experiences for Indigenous pregnant persons (Life-Givers) accessing health and wellness services at **Surrey Memorial Hospital**. The IML position supports Indigenous Life-Givers with navigating the health care system, and connection to community supports, including to a birth keeper (doula).



## When to call:

- If you or a Life-Giver you know is pregnant or has just had a baby and needs support, you can call the IML referral line. The IML position can help with the care journey in community or at Surrey Memorial Hospital.
