

Register. Book. Get the shot.

1

First, you **register and get a confirmation number**. You need that number to later book your vaccination appointment.

Register:

- **Online:**
gov.bc.ca/getvaccinated
- **By telephone:**
1-833-838-2323 (toll free). Interpreters available.
By telephone for the deaf and hard of hearing: 7-1-1
- **In-person:**
Visit the nearest Service BC location

To register, you must provide:

- Date of birth
- Postal code
- Personal Health Number*
- An email address that gets checked regularly or a phone number that can receive text messages.

*If you don't have a Personal Health Number, please register by phone or in person at a BC Services Centre. Everyone **living, working or studying** in B.C. can get a **free** COVID-19 vaccine. You do not need to be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident to get the vaccine.

You will be contacted to book a vaccine appointment when you are eligible. You will book your appointment online or by phone. You will select a location, date and time.

3

Visit the immunization clinic to get your vaccine.

People who get their first vaccine dose will be notified by email, text or phone call when they are eligible to book an appointment for their **second dose**.
