**Water Sampling Instructions for Water System Operators** 

#### **GATHER SAMPLING SUPPLIES**

- 1. Sterile 250 ml Sample Bottle \*
- 2. Requisition Form \*
- 3. Disinfectant Alcohol Swab or Bleach
- 4. Zip lock Plastic Bag and Elastic Band
- 5. Cooler and Ice Pack
  - \* Available from the Health Units



#### LABEL SAMPLE BOTTLE

Information Required

- 1. Sample collection location
- 2. Date and time sample was collected
- 3. Name of Water System

#### **COLLECT SAMPLE**

- 1. Remove the aerator, swivel or hose attached to the tap.
- 2. **D**isinfect the tap with an alcohol wipe or strong chlorine solution prior to collecting the sample.
- 3. **R**un the water for a minimum of 2 minutes before sampling.

#### **COLLECT SAMPLE - Continued**

- 4. **Do not rinse** the bottle. The white powder is a dechlorinating agent.
- 5. **Do not touch** the neck of the bottle or the inside of the cap so as to avoid contaminating the sample.
- 6. **Fill** the bottle with water to the fill line mark (approximately <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> full).
- 7. **R**eplace cap.





### **COMPLETE REQUISITION FORM**

- 1. Fill in Sampler's Name.
- 2. Fill in **Date and Time** sample was collected.
- 3. Place the **Requisition Form** inside the plastic Bag.
- 4. **Attach** the bag to the bottle with an elastic band.

#### TRANSPORT SAMPLE

- 1. Using a Cooler and Ice pack transport water samples to the designated Health Unit as soon as possible after collection.
- 2. **IMPORTANT:** Water samples must be submitted to the Health Unit the Same Day the sample is collected.
