

Violation Ticket Offences Issued Against Food Facilities

Every operator of a food service establishment (including restaurants, caterers, take out and mobile food providers) must have a health operating permit. Environmental Health Officers conduct inspections of these facilities, stores and some processing facilities to ensure health standards are being met. This includes food handling, storage temperatures, sanitation, employee hygiene and procedures for cleaning and sanitizing. They also provide education to food handlers and consumers about safe food handling practices.

Environmental Health Officers employed by Fraser Health Authority complete routine, follow-up and complaint inspections to help ensure that facilities are compliance with the applicable public health legislation. Officers have a variety of tools at their discretion which include but are not limited to education, violation tickets, orders and court action.
