Steps to Log on:

Type in search engine “Learning Hub PHSA”

Click on “PHSA Learning Hub – Provincial Health Services Authority”

Click on “Sign up for an account” if you don’t already have an account.

Account type must be under “FH employee” if not, some courses will not show up.

Verify ID if you have an employee number already. If not, click on “Remind me later.”

Enter your Fraser Health (FH) e-mail address. If you do not have your FH email address yet, you may use your personal email. **\*However, once your FH email address is received you must change it to FH email address immediately or the reports will not show up with FH Workplace Health.\***

After logging on: Type in course name exactly as stated above. See under “Search for course under these names” and it is important to choose the right course.

Click on “Register Course” and then “Start Course”

For the Dementia course. Once you have completed the modules you must then print the ARQ, complete it and bring it in for the orientation. If you cannot print this, the educator can provide you a copy to complete during orientation.

After completion of ALL courses, go To “Learning History.” Click on “Print Transcript” to print up list of completed modules (avoid printing individual certificates) or send transcript in attachment via email.
