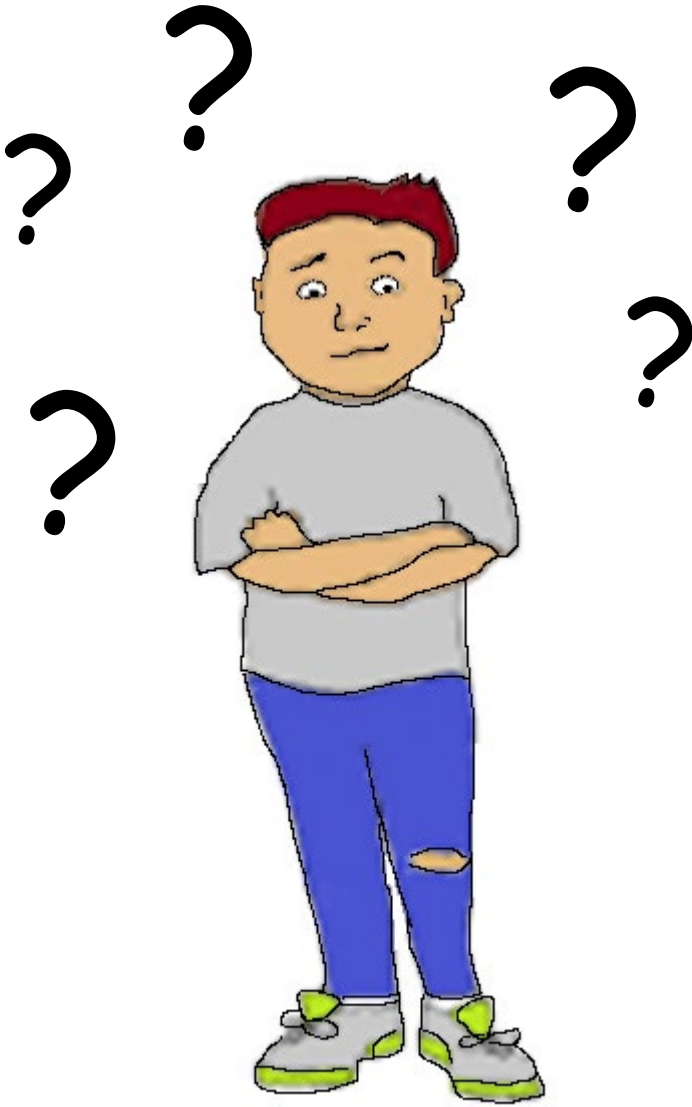




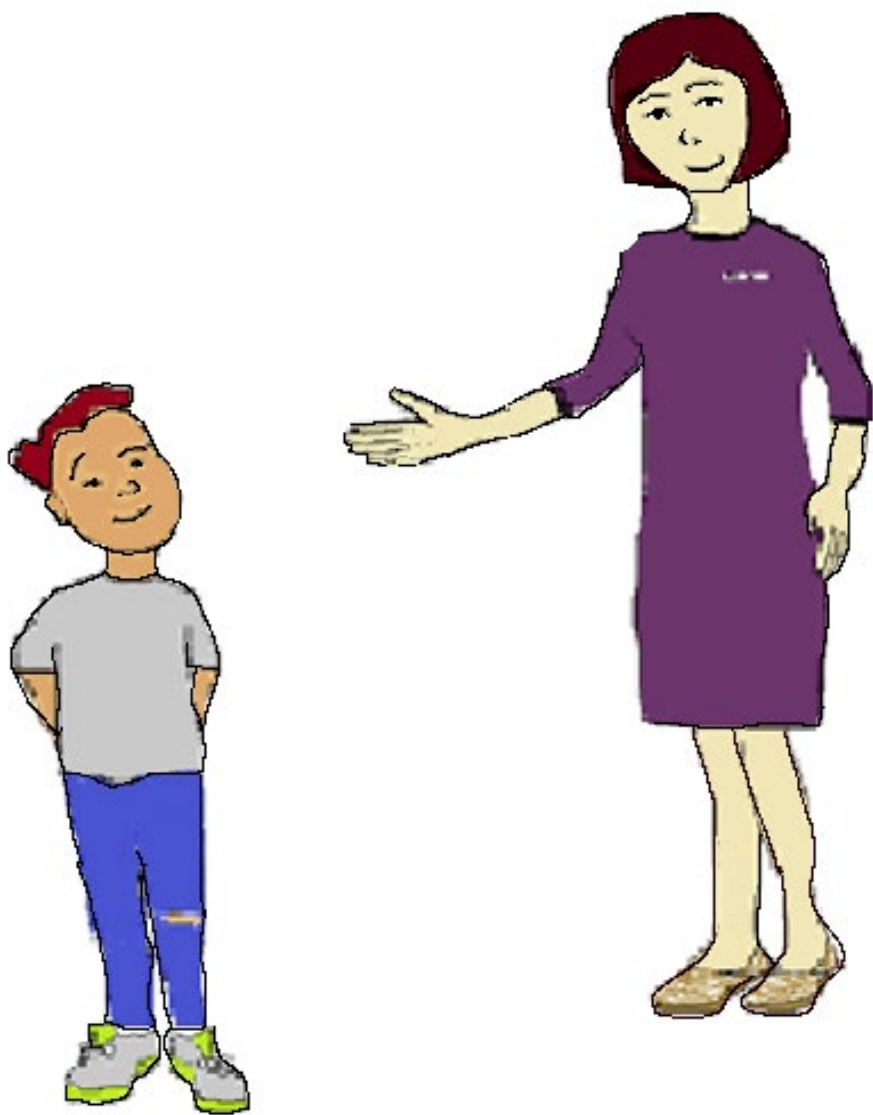
# Tommy's Force Field

On the day that Tommy had to get his immunizations, he didn't know what to think.

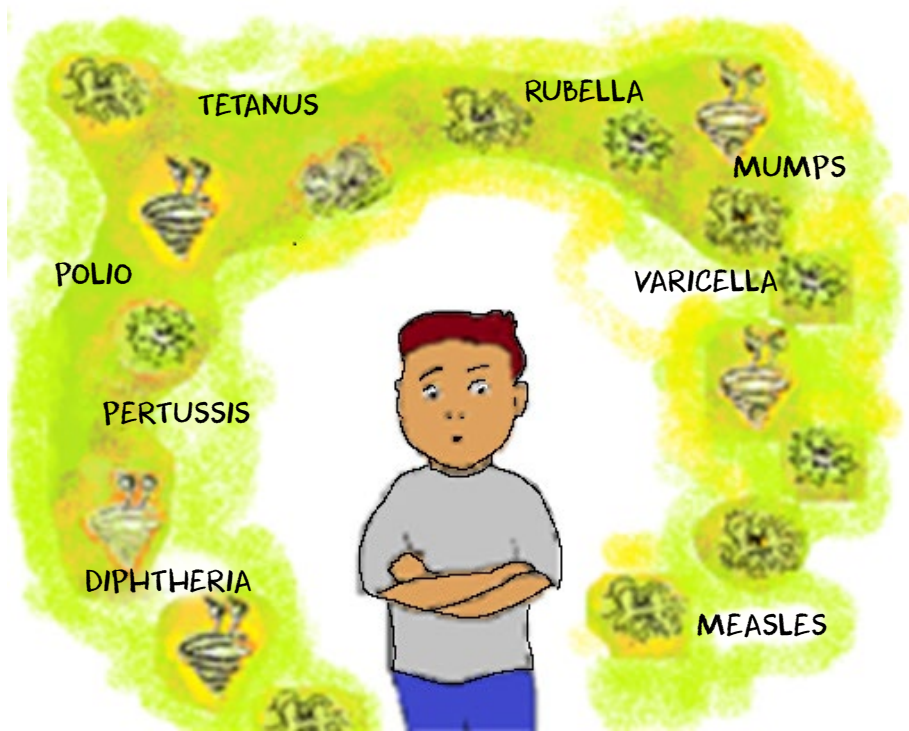
When he met the nurse she seemed friendly,

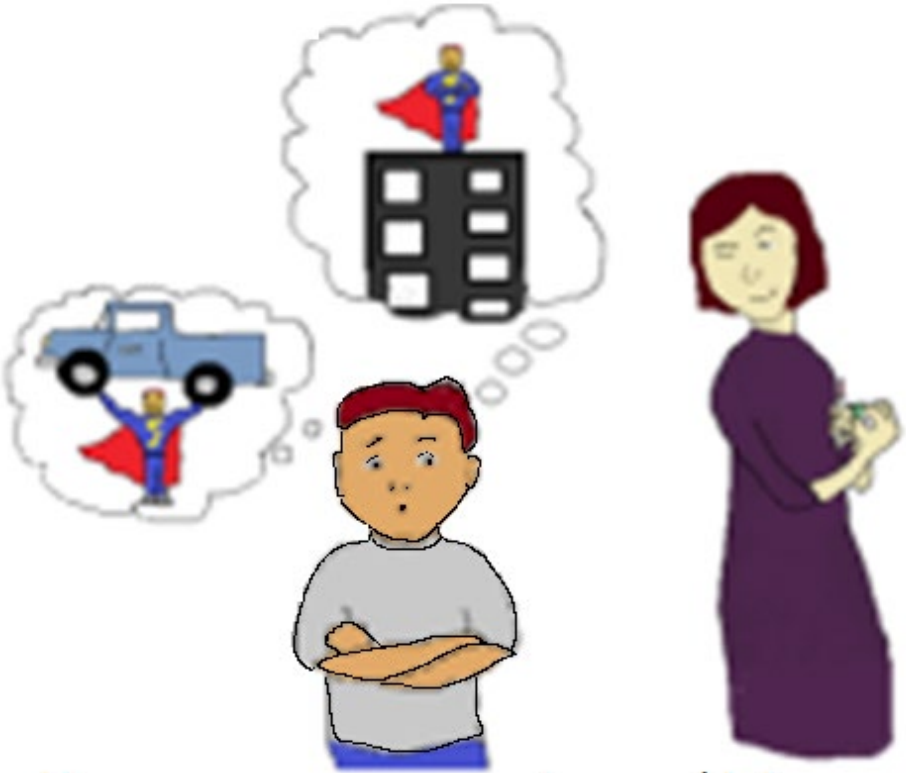


The nurse explained that it's normal to feel nervous about getting your superhero boosters. She said that even the greatest superheros of all times have been a little nervous.
