**IC8: 0240 Appendix IV Scabies Check List**

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Contact IPC Practitioner when first case identified	
Implement contact precautions and wear Personal protective equipment as per routine and contact precautions	
Send Notification to staff, contractors/volunteers	
Provide scabies fact sheet and visitor script to staff and families/visitors	
Maintain resident line list	
Place suspected or confirmed residents on contact precautions until 24 hours after last treatment	
Discharge clean room following each treatment and ensure all bedding, curtains and personal care supplies are discarded or cleaned	
If resident must be transferred, notify receiving facility of cluster before the transfer	
Ensure hand hygiene supplies are available for resident use	
Affected staff may return to work 24 hours after treatment	
Staff, volunteers, students who work in another facility to notify other facility before working there and if affected not to work	
Cohort staff where possible.	
Inform family members of affected residents if they have visited in the last 4-6 weeks	
Signs alerting visitors to cluster posted at all entrances to the affected floors.	
Dedicate or low level disinfect equipment between resident use	
Follow routine practices for handling clinical waste/soiled linen	
Hand Hygiene signage posted and hand washing supplies available for visitors and staff
