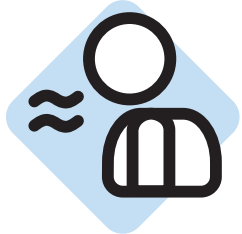


SIGNS OF AN OPIOID OVERDOSE

Learn how to spot an overdose and what to do.



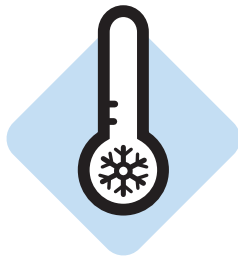
Breathing

or snoring sounds



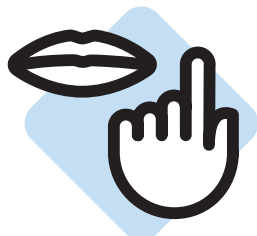
Cold

of lips and nails

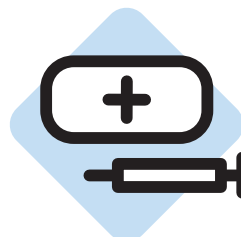
