Tobacco Enforcement Officers employed by Fraser Health Authority complete routine, follow-up and complaint inspections to help ensure that facilities are complinace with the applicable public health legislation. Officers have a variety of tools at their discretion which include but are not limited to education, violation tickets, orders and court action.
