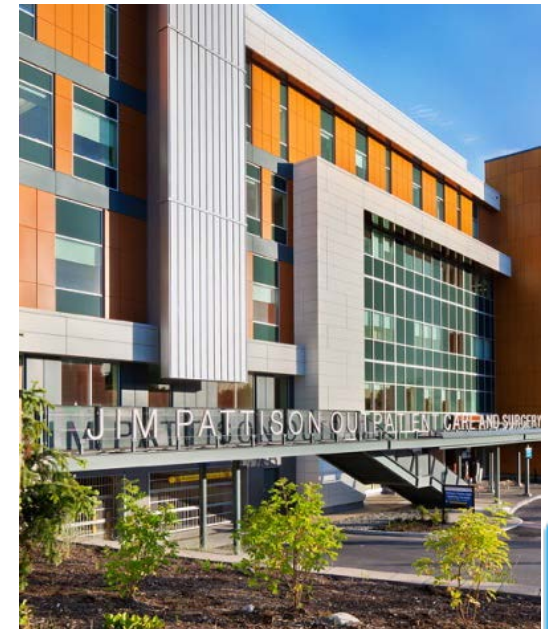

We serve the community of Surrey, as well as provide some Fraser Health region-wide services.

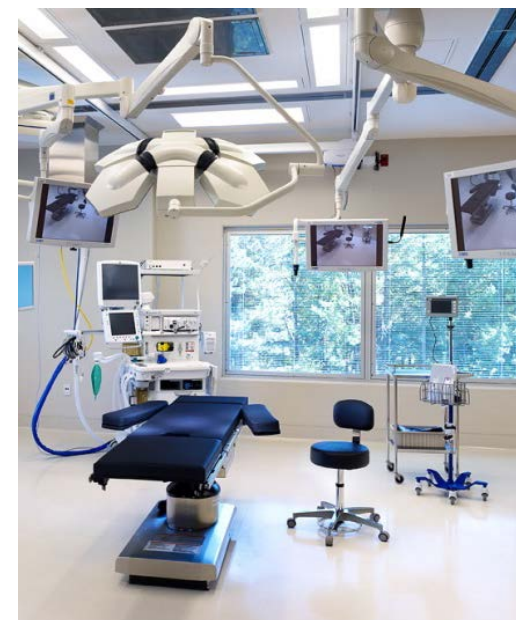
Diagnostic Testing

Day Surgery and Ambulatory Procedures

- Surgical ambulatory procedures (endoscopy; urology procedures; colposcopy; minor surgical procedures; minor ear, nose, throat procedures; pain procedures)
- Surgery: six operating rooms (complex ear, nose, throat procedures; pacemaker and other cardiac electrical device implantation; breast mastectomy and reconstruction; orthopedic procedures and others)
