

# Fact Sheet: Complex Care Housing, Congregate, Surrey

### Supportive housing and enhanced health services in Surrey: Foxglove

Foxglove supportive housing is located in Surrey and operated by non-profit service provider RainCity Housing. Enhanced care services are included with 39 self-contained units. Program participants are offered life skills support and counselling, nursing care, mental health services, addiction medicine and cultural supports. Participants pay the shelter portion of provincial assistance or equivalent and sign a participation agreement.

#### Who are the participants?

Surrey community members aged 19 and older experiencing challenges with daily functioning due to mental illness, substance use and/or co-occurring health needs not met by the current model of supportive or other forms of housing and that are contributing to homelessness and/or frequent hospitalizations.

Participants are:

- Eligible for BC Housing Supportive Housing (low income adult)
- Open to enhanced health services to support housing stability
- Able to have health care needs scheduled via an individual plan
- Able to make decisions on their own behalf in relation to functional safety
  Supports are offered for:
  - o Behaviours that may lead to eviction
  - Managing guests
  - o Harm reduction

- o Onsite health services
- Medication management
- o Developing life skills

#### What can a person expect?

- Self-contained private units with bathroom
- An individual plan that they develop
- Three meals per day

- Shared laundry facilities
- A culturally safe environment
- Overdose prevention services

## How do people access this program?

The Community Access and Assessment Table operated by BC Housing will consider candidates brought forward by community partners, including Fraser Health. When there is a vacancy, a candidate will be prioritized for referral by the table. (Note: families and individuals can reach out to an agency or Fraser Health for a referral
