

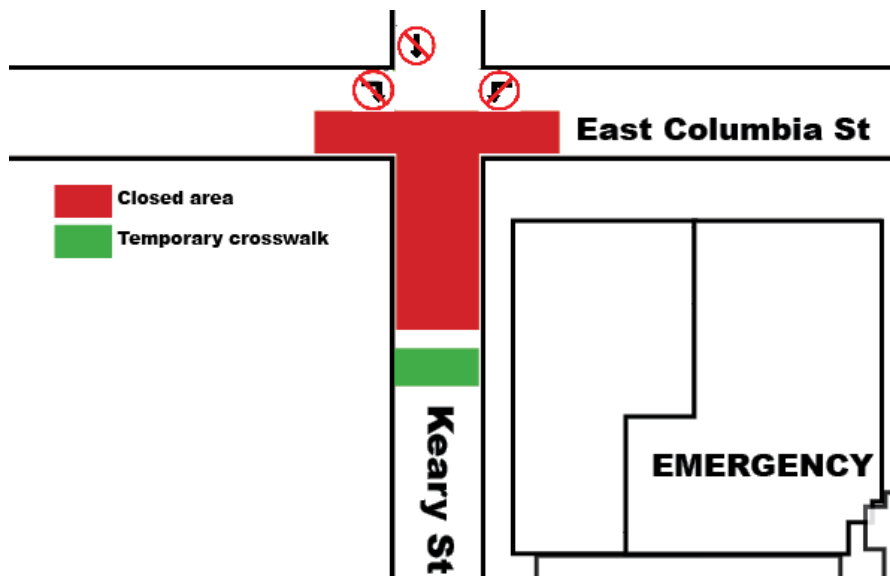
Construction Notice for Neighbours

Keary Street intersection work

What's happening?

- The intersection at Keary Street and East Columbia Street will be closed for one day on **Saturday, October 5** from approximately 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- The closure is needed in order to remove the old asphalt, grade the gravel to the new design and pave the area as part of the City of New Westminster's '[Great Street](#)' project.
- East Columbia Street remains open but there will be no access to or from Keary Street.



How will this affect you?

- Drivers will not be able to turn to or from East Columbia Street onto Keary Street.
- There will be no access to the hospital Emergency Department from Keary Street.
- Ambulances and emergency vehicles must access the hospital via East Columbia Street.
- The hospital's parkade on Keary Street will only be accessible via Brunette Avenue.
- There will be flaggers on site to assist drivers and pedestrians.
- There will be no parking on both sides of East Columbia and Keary streets in the work area.
- Expect delays.
