## Revised Additional Precautions Signage

### What is happening?

- Infection Prevention and Control (IPC) is introducing the revised additional precautions signage starting **November 4, 2024**.
- The Provincial Infection Prevention and Control Network (PICNet) introduced new provincial templates for additional precautions signage. To support standardized approach throughout the province, Fraser Health will be introducing the revised signage:
  - Contact Precautions (PS#323288)
  - Contact Precautions Plus (PS#413248)
  - Droplet Precautions (PS#323289)
  - Airborne Precautions (PS#323286)
  - Aerosol Generating Procedure (PS#258001)
  - Enhanced Barrier Precautions (PS#259365) (long-term care and hospice only)

### How this may affect you?

- Healthcare providers are required to use the revised signage for patients on additional precautions or undergoing aerosol generating procedures.
- Long-term care communities that are owned and operated by Fraser Health can order the sign from Fraser Health Stores Catalogue. There is no change in Fraser Health Stores Catalogue numbers (PS#s) for the revised signage.
- Affiliated care communities to print the sign from [IPC Manual](#)
- No need to discard the old signage – order the revised signage once the old signage supplies run out.
