# \*UPDATE\* Regional Pre-Printed Order for Prevention and Treatment of Viral Respiratory Illness in Long-Term Care

- **REVISED** Regional Pre-Printed Order for Prevention and Treatment of Viral Respiratory Illness in Long-Term Care
- The Regional Pre-Printed Order for Prevention and Treatment of Viral Respiratory Illness in Long-Term Care has been updated due to the change in pneumococcal vaccine from pneumococcal polysaccharide vaccine (PPV23) to pneumococcal conjugate vaccine 20 valent (PCV20).

### • Revisions:

- To review resident's pneumococcal vaccination history and medical condition(s) prior to ordering.
- Refer to BC Centre for Disease Control (BCCDC) Immunization Manual: Part 4- Biological Products (Vaccines & Immune Globulins) for Pneumococcal vaccines see PREVNAR 20 for eligibility criteria

- o New product pneumococcal conjugate vaccine 20-valent (PREVNAR 20) 0.5 mL IM x 1 dose

### Eligibility:

- A resident without certain high-risk medical conditions is eligible for one dose of PCV20 if not previously vaccinated with PCV20, PCV21 or PPV23.
- A resident with certain high-risk medical conditions is eligible for one dose of PCV20 even if they have received one or sometimes two doses of PPV23.
- No booster doses of PCV20 are recommended at this time.

- o Additional education about pneumococcal vaccine 20 will be provided at Flu school.
