- The new Regional PPO for Prevention and Treatment of Viral Respiratory Illness in Long-Term Care has been developed. This new PPO replaces the Physician Orders Template Residential Influenza Protocol
- The PPO includes a pre-screen section, laboratory, test and pharmacological treatment for prevention of respiratory illness in Long-Term Care (LTC).
