PIECES™ Education for Long-Term Care (LTC) and Assisted Living (AL)

What's happening?

- PIECES™ education is available to LTC and AL direct care nurses (RN/RPN/LPN), clinical leads (e.g. Resident Care Coordinator, Director of Care, CNE, SW) and other regulated health care providers.
- The program is delivered virtually via ZOOM over two full days (one-week apart).
- PIECES™ provides health care practitioners with a practical, reflective and evidence informed approach to guide *collaborative engagement, shared assessment, and supportive care* with older adults at risk or living with complex conditions and changes in behavioural expression associated with:
 - Neurocognitive disorders (including but not limited to dementia)
 - Mental and substance use disorders
 - Other neurological conditions
 - Physical health complexities
- PIECES™ is a nationally recognized program supported by the BC Ministry of Health.
