### **\*NEW\*** LTC Owned and Operated only Influenza Immunization Reporting in ImmsBC

- Starting the week of Oct 10<sup>th</sup>, influenza immunizations must be recorded in the ImmsBC documentation system for all LTC owned and operated
- ImmsBC is a new provincial system used to document COVID-19 and influenza immunizations. ImmsBC feeds immunization information directly into the Provincial Immunization Registry
