### **\*UPDATE\*** Provincial Medical Assistance in Dying (MAiD) forms for both patients & assessors must be used on/after January 1, 2023

- Updated forms reflect new federal reporting requirements and are now available on the [MAiD PULSE page](#) and from the [BC Ministry of Health MAiD website](#).
- Please use the new forms for ALL new requests going forward. If an “old” Request form from a patient has been completed, it will still be accepted.
- Changes to forms:
  - Specific to capturing a persons *self-identified* gender, race, indigenous identity and disability in order to better understand the characteristics of people requesting MAiD, and capture information to improve health equity for all Canadians.
  - People can absolutely decline to answer some or all of the questions. This will not affect their request for MAiD or determination of eligibility.

### **\*REMINDER\*** Influenza Readiness Reports – Friendly reminder these are due as soon as possible

- The Readiness Report is a provincial requirement and needs to be reported to Public Health using Cerberus file sharing service
- If Cerberus is down or the site is unable to access it, the site can **fax the Readiness report to CD Nursing Team @ 604-507-5439**. Public Health requires these to report back to the province.
