UPDATE Spring COVID-19 Immunization Program

- Starting soon in April, 2024 additional doses of <u>XBB.1.5 containing COVID-19</u> will be available to long-term care and assisted living residents, Indigenous individuals aged 55 and older, CEV Group 1 and 2 ages six months and older, as well as anyone in community over the age of 65.
- Anyone who has not received a dose of the XBB.1.5 COVID-19 vaccine is also eligible. A minimum three month interval between doses is required.
- All residents in long-term care, assisted living and anyone over the age of 65 will be offered a Spring dose if they are eligible. ImmsBC is to be used for all resident registration and vaccine administration for these doses.
