NEW Resuming use of bag valve mask (BVM) for resuscitation in Long-Term Care and Assisted Living Communities

- Effective immediately, all long-term care and assisted living care teams can resume the use of BMV in resuscitations, as taught in current CPR and Basic Life Support courses.
- Staff must wear the appropriate PPE for high-risk Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGPs) and follow the Aerosol Generating Procedure Guideline: <u>Aerosol Generating Procedures (AGP) [SOP]</u> (fraserhealth.ca)
