



Construction Notice

Expect disruption on Keary St. near Brunette Ave. on Saturday, July 22

What's Happening The westbound lane of Keary Street from the hospital's east service lane to its parkade entrance may be disrupted for about 4 hours, starting around 9:00am.

We sincerely apologize for the short notice! A construction container installed this week was placed incorrectly and is impeding access to an exit, so our construction partner needs to move the container ASAP.

Scope of Work/Area Affected A large crane and truck will be moving the storage container at the southeast exterior corner of the hospital. Much of the work is expected to happen on hospital property, but Keary Street may be impacted.

Impact to You Please be careful as you turn right from Brunette Avenue onto Keary Street as this area may be more congested and vehicles may be backed up along Keary Street. Alternatively, use East Columbia Street to access Keary Street and to avoid much of the congestion.

Obey all construction flagpersons. They are there for your safety and protection and will be directing alternating traffic, and pedestrians.

Anvil Condominiums will still have access to their parkade.
