



Construction Notice for Neighbours

Keary Street will be closed near Brunette Avenue Friday, August 18 and Saturday, August 19

What's Happening A second construction crane is being installed on the south side of the hospital's construction site

Scope of Work/Area Affected Bird Construction has informed us for two days the south part of Keary Street from Brunette Avenue to the hospital's east parkade entrance will be closed or reduced to one lane of traffic while large trucks and equipment install a second construction crane, from approximately 7am to 8pm both days. (Dates and times are subject to change)

Impact to You Bird Construction has indicated the following to us:

Right turns from Brunette Avenue onto Keary Street will not be possible for these two days from 7am to 8pm. Use East Columbia Street to access Keary Street. (Accessing Keary Street from Sherbrooke Street is not possible at this time)

Residents of Anvil Condominiums will not be able to turn right when exiting their parkade (towards Brunette) from approximately 7am to 8pm.

- Enter and exit the parkade by accessing Keary Street via East Columbia Street during these two days.
- You will see 'No Through Road' and 'Road Closed' signs at or near the East Columbia/Keary Street intersection but you can still proceed to access the Anvil and hospital parkades, just not Brunette.

Pedestrians should use the sidewalk along Brunette Avenue to access SkyTrain if they live in Copperstone condos or north of Sherbrooke Street and use the hospital's service lane as a shortcut. The sidewalk on the south side of Keary Street will be open.

Obey all construction flagpersons. They are there for your safety and protection.

We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience. Bird Construction and their contractors will endeavour to minimize the impact of noise, dust and disruption to our neighbours in accordance with the City's regulations and [Good Neighbour Protocol](#).
