Sidewalk closing on north side of Keary Street

What's Happening The north sidewalk along Keary Street near Brunette Avenue will close until mid-April 2018

Scope of Work/Area Affected Bird Construction has indicated they will close the sidewalk along Keary Street next to the mental health construction site, between Brunette Avenue and the hospital's east service lane. The sidewalk will be closed in mid-November and likely until mid-April for safety reasons and to facilitate construction at the site.

The south sidewalk will still be available in front of Anvil Condominiums.

The City is aware of this closure and has issued appropriate permits.

Impact to You Pedestrians should use Keary Street's south sidewalk to access SkyTrain. Please watch for large trucks turning at the corner, and cars exiting Anvil's parkade.

Obey all construction flag persons. They are there for your safety and protection. We encourage you to ask them when it's safe to cross the Brunette/Keary Street intersection.
