

COVID-19: Long-Term Care Updates

March 16, 2020

Topic: Visitors, Screening and Resident Transfers

As the situation on COVID-19 continues to evolve, long-term care homes must take enhanced precautions to support safe and secure environment for our residents:

- *NEW* Limit visitors to only essential adult visitors: Essential visitors include visitors
 attending for compassionate reasons such as residents who are dying or very ill, visitors assisting
 with resident feeding etc.
- 2. *NEW* Post the "do not visit if ill poster". The March 15th version of the poster includes additional guidelines for individuals with ANY cough, fever, or other respiratory symptoms (attached to email)
- **3.** *NEW* Transfers between units should only occur based on client care needs (i.e. from general population to Behavioural Support Transition Neighbourhood and vice versa)
- 4. Continue to actively screen essential visitors to the site at the entrance to the facility each time they visit:
