Revised Coronavirus-2019 (COVID-19) Testing Guidelines

Patient Status	Specimen Type	O/E Order
Outpatients (Clinics and non- admitted Emergency patients)	1 NP swab (preferred) OR 1 viral Throat swab	O/E: order both MIC-VIRESP and MIC-CORONA Source - NP or Throat
Inpatients (Admitted patients)	1 NP swab And 1 viral Throat swab or Sputum or ET aspirate	O/E: order both MIC-FLURSV and MIC-CORONA Source - NP swab O/E: order only MIC-CORONA Source - Throat or Sputum or ET aspirate

- In Fraser Health, COVID-19 testing will ONLY be performed if CORONA is ordered.
 In Fraser Health, COVID-19 testing IS NOT performed automatically on all specimens with FLU/RSV test requests.

Nasopharyngeal swab (NP Swab) Or Viral Throat swab IMPORTANT: Reserve the red top viral tube for pediatric patients	 Red top viral tube containing a pink liquid transport medium Or Blue top viral tube containing a pink liquid transport medium Or Hologics Aptima Unisex Swab Specimen Collection Kit Note: Discard the Aptima Cleaning swab 	COPAN CO
Sputum Or ET aspirate	Sterile container	 Collection requires a wide mouth screw cap container Instruct the patient not to spit into the sample container, but to take a deep breath and cough directly into the container
