8 REASONS TO USE REALTIME CTMS



Clinical Trial Management System (CTMS) is designed to streamline clinical research activities and to allow for seamless integration of research and technology. It is compliant with regulatory requirements for Health Canada and FDA.



CTMS is a central place for recording operational activities throughout a clinical trial.

1 PATIENT DATABASE MANAGEMENT

Build a patient database for both patients who have enrolled in a clinical trial and for patients who have expressed consent to contact for future studies. Track progress during participant recruitment and enrollment. Export lists to Excel with the click of a button.



2 ACCOUNTING & BUDGETING

Track revenue, costs and profitability. Build your budget templates according to the study event schedule. Create invoices to sponsors for completed/monitored visits or other study revenue items as needed.




Easily schedule study specific visits in the CTMS and receive an Outlook event calendar as a reminder. Invite additional team members to study appointments if needed.



4 ELECTRONIC REGULATORY MANAGEMENT

eDocs helps reduce redundancy and decrease opportunities for poor clinical practices. For example, paper-based central files such as staff professional documents (licenses, CVs, certifications), and equipment calibration records can be kept electronically. Automatic reminders for expiring documents allow staff to renew them in time. eDocs allows for long-term archive of regulatory and redacted study documents after study close-out with no annual storage fees.



5 REMOTE MONITORING PORTAL

Online access for sponsors to review, track, and issue queries on electronic regulatory documents.



RealTime CTMS has passed the required security and privacy assessments both provincially and at Fraser Health.



As a part of the BC Academic Health Science Network Provincial CTMS Program, we have a robust community to promote knowledge sharing and collaboration for continuous improvement.



8 FUTURE ADD-ONS

Provincially, we are working on adding RealTime Text (automatically sending appointment confirmation & reminders to patients) and SitePay (integrated payment system for patients) to the RealTime CTMS and eDocs.
