Visitor Restrictions Are in Effect



All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and other respiratory illness prior to every visit.



A medical mask is required for all staff and visitors in patient areas. Please use the mask provided.



Clean hands using soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer before and after visiting.



Cough or sneeze into your elbow and do not touch your face.



Respect personal space.



Up to two visitors at a time are allowed.*

*Emergency rooms and intensive care units are limited to one support person at a time. More than two visitors may be allowed for pediatric care, labour and delivery, palliative and end-of-life care.
