

Violation Ticket Offenses Issued Against Drinking Water System

Anyone who owns or operates a water supply system which provides water for domestic purposes requires a valid water supply operating permit. Environmental Health Officers routinely inspect, sample and assess community water systems for compliance with the Drinking Water Protection Act and Regulation.

Environmental Health Officers employed by Fraser Health Authority complete routine, follow-up and complaint inspections to help ensure that facilities are in compliance with the applicable public health legislation. Officers have a variety of tools at their discretion which include but are not limited to education, violation tickets, orders and court action.
