

OVERDOSE RESPONSE PUBLIC REPORT, AUGUST 2021

FATAL OVERDOSES

- According to BC Coroners Service, there were 58 illicit drug toxicity deaths in Fraser Health in July 2021 and 52 in June 2021.
- Based on the first seven months of 2021, deaths have increased by 20% compared to 2020
- The largest increases have been in Chilliwack, New Westminster, and Burnaby (Table 1).

Illicit drug toxicity deaths reported by BC Coroners Service include illicit drug overdoses involving street drugs (heroin, cocaine, MDMA, methamphetamine, etc.), medications that were not prescribed to the deceased, combinations of the above, with prescribed medications, and those overdoses where the origin of drug is not known.

OVERDOSES ATTENDED BY BC PARAMEDICS

- BC paramedics responded to 910 overdoses across Fraser Health in August 2021 and 1017 in July 2021.
- Based on the first eight months of 2021, the rate of overdose events have increased by 39% compared to 2020.
- Many communities are seeing increases in overdose events, especially Pitt Meadows and Agassiz / Harrison (Table 2).
