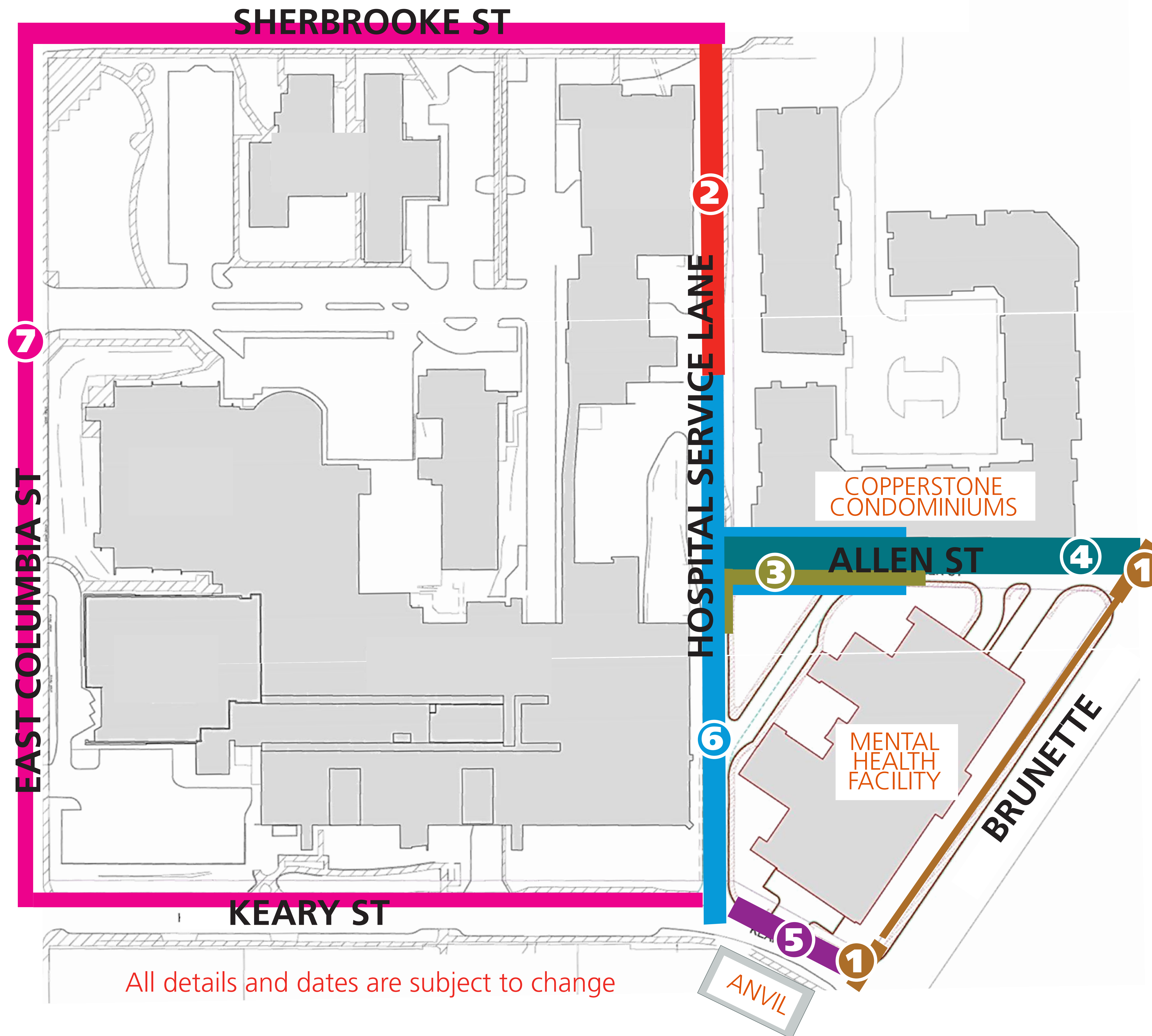


ROAD & SIDEWALK DISRUPTIONS during Phase One (updated July 2017)



Roads and sidewalks along the hospital's perimeter will be disrupted for installation of IT and utilities pathways. Our goal, where possible, is to dig up roads only once to minimize disruption for our neighbours and to maximize construction efficiency.

1 end of June to mid July 2017

Electrical conduit will be installed along the east side of the construction site disrupting the intersections at Brunette Avenue and Allen and Keary Streets, for about 2-5 days each, which may make them wheelchair inaccessible. The sidewalk will remain open, but may be disrupted.

2 end of June to end of October 2017

The northern part of the hospital's lane will close to all traffic. Its east sidewalk will be removed, as may vegetation, then be replaced. Copperstone condominiums will not have lane access from their west exterior stairs.

3 early or mid July 2017

The first construction crane will be installed causing road closures or disruption to Allen Street and the hospital's service lane for 2-5 days.

4 mid July to end of July 2017

Allen Street will close to traffic one lane at a time for underground utility work. Access to Copperstone condominium's parkade will be maintained. The sidewalk will remain open but may be disrupted at times.

5 late July to mid August 2017; early 2018

Part of Keary Street will be disrupted in 2017 to install the second crane, and then again in late 2017 to early 2018 when one lane at a time will be closed for water/sewer excavation. Sidewalks may be impacted.

6 mid October 2017 to early 2020

The southern part of the hospital's service lane will close to all traffic and pedestrians from north of Allen Street to Keary Street for excavation of utilities, a tunnel, and overhead link. The west half of Allen Street will also close to all traffic for excavation, and then for construction storage — its north sidewalk will remain open, but may be disrupted at times.

7 during 2018

One lane of traffic and sidewalks will close in sections along Sherbrooke, East Columbia and Keary Streets for excavation. Parking along the open lane may be temporarily closed in sections too. Access to hospital and Emergency entry/exits/parking lots will be maintained.
