## **Drone video flight planned for this Monday**

# What's Happening A video drone will be flying over the hospital on Monday afternoon, March 20th

Area Affected/Scope Video footage of the entire hospital campus will be taken for an historical of work record 'before' mental health facility construction, weather permitting.

### You may see the drone:

- around the construction site that's between Allen Street and Keary Street, including the lane running from Sherbrooke Street to Keary Street
- along Sherbrooke, East Columbia, and Keary Streets
- over the industrial park east of Brunette Avenue
- over the hospital's main entrance.

We expect filming to take several hours and will be done by <u>UAviation</u>, a qualified, experienced, and licensed drone operator.

We have alerted the necessary authorities including Transport Canada, the City of New Westminster, BC Air Ambulance, police, and Fraser Health. UAviation's team will ensure Transport Canada guidelines are met which require a 100-foot (30-metre) safety perimeter around the drone's launch site, flight path and landing area.

**The drone will be 'grounded'** if any helicopters arrive during filming.

Impact to You Our neighbour's privacy will be respected. Footage intends to capture the current state of the hospital, not of the neighbourhood. Any footage used in future videos will be edited to respect personal privacy.

> The drone's flight path will not interfere with any neighbourhood construction cranes.
