Drone video flight happens Thursday, July 6, 2017

What's Happening A video drone will be flying over the hospital on Thursday, July 6 in the late morning

Area Affected/Scope You may see the drone:

- of work around the construction site between Allen Street and Keary Street, including the lane running from Sherbrooke Street to Keary Street
 - · along Sherbrooke, East Columbia, and Keary Streets
 - over Sapperton Park
 - over the hospital's main entrance.

We expect filming to take several hours by the team from UAviation, a qualified, experienced, and licensed drone operator.

We have alerted the necessary authorities including Transport Canada, the City of New Westminster, BC Air Ambulance, the local police department, and Fraser Health. Transport Canada requires a 100-foot (30-metre) safety perimeter around the UAV's launch site, flight path and landing area. Operation manager and ground supervisors will be on-hand to advise when the flight safety area is closed to the public.

The drone will be 'grounded' if any helicopters arrive during filming.

Impact to You Our neighbour's privacy will be respected. Footage intends to capture the current state of the hospital, not of the neighbourhood. Any footage used in future videos will be edited to respect the privacy of people who live in our community, or who are visiting our hospital.

> The drone's flight path will not interfere with any nearby construction cranes.
