BRUNETTE AVENUE lane closures

between Allen and Keary Streets on Saturday, August 26

What's Large trucks will be delivering and pumping Happening concrete into the hospital's construction site

Scope of Work/Area Affected Bird Construction has informed us on Saturday, August 26, from about 7am to 8pm both southbound lanes of BRUNETTE AVENUE between Keary Street and Allen Street will be closed for large concrete trucks accessing the construction site on the east side of the hospital. One northbound lane will be temporarily used for southbound traffic (Dates and times are subject to change).

Impact to You Bird Construction has indicated the following:

Expect traffic along Brunette Avenue to be slower as vehicles merge into diverted lanes near the hospital and concrete trucks move in and out of place.

Access via Brunette to/from Keary and Allen Streets will be possible.

Pedestrians should avoid that portion of Brunette's sidewalk, even though the sidewalk will remain open. Use Allen Street and the south portion of the hospital's private service lane for SkyTrain access.

Obey all construction flag persons. They are there for your safety and protection.

We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience. Bird Construction and their contractors will endeavour to minimize the impact of noise, dust and disruption to our neighbours in accordance with the City's regulations and <u>Good Neighbour Protocol</u>.
