# Paving to start on Sherbrooke St between Fader Street and Kelly Street

#### What's happening, where, and when

Bird Construction indicates starting the week of April 9<sup>th</sup> the south (hospital-side) of Sherbrooke Street will be prepped for paving from just east of Fader Street to Kelly Street's lane. Weather permitting, road preparations are expected to take 1 week, and paving one or two days.

During this work, at times Sherbrooke Street may be reduced to a single lane of traffic but for the most part will maintain two lanes of traffic.

### The Impact To You

**Expect delays and disruption along Sherbrooke Street** and frequent changes in access. Thank you for your patience.

**Pedestrians can use the south sidewalk at all times** (hospital-side of Sherbrooke Street) which will remain open.

Please use caution, and obey all construction flag persons; they are there for your safety and protection.

**Construction equipment will continue to be stored** in some areas of the south lane (hospital-side) of Sherbrooke Street once paving is complete.

We sincerely apologize for the inconvenience. Bird Construction will endeavour to minimize the impact of noise, dust, and disruption to our neighbours in accordance with the City's regulations and <a href="Good Neighbour Protocol">Good Neighbour Protocol</a>. Construction hours are 7am to 8pm, Monday to Saturday (but not Sundays or holidays).
