



## Construction Notice for Neighbours

### West half of Allen Street is closing in April

**What's Happening** Around mid-April the west half of Allen Street will close for construction of the new mental health facility

**Area Affected/Scope of work** The portion of Allen Street from just west of Copperstone's south parkade entrance to the hospital's road/lane will be fenced and excavated. Construction trailers will be installed and stay in place until all construction on the new mental health facility finishes in Winter 2019.

Once construction finishes the road will be repaved, [bollard posts](#) will be installed, and a sidewalk will be added on the south side of Allen St.

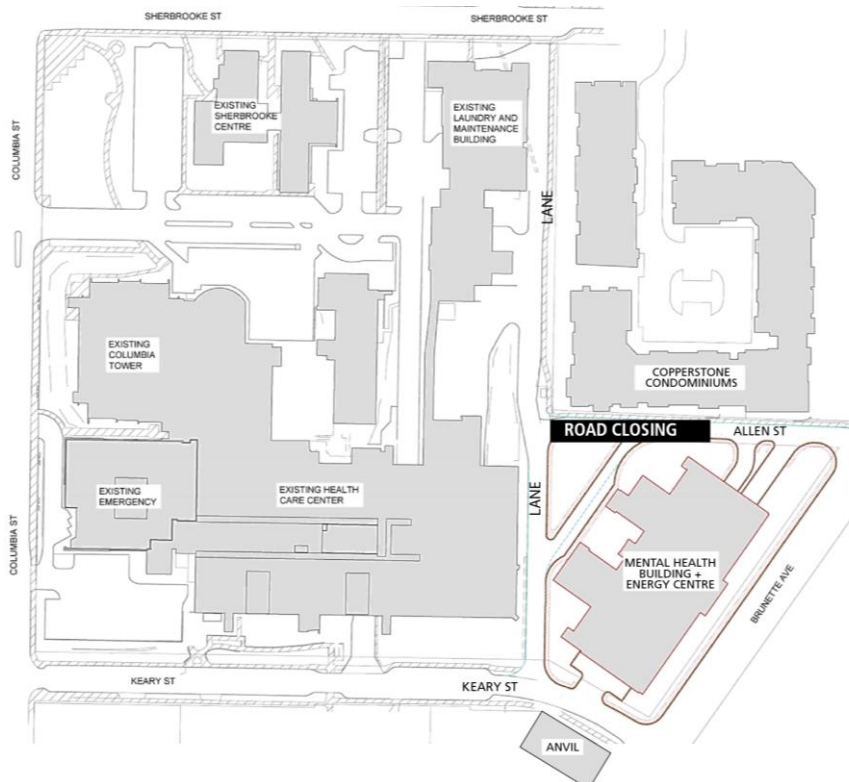
**Impact to You** Public vehicle traffic will no longer be possible from Allen St. to Sherbrooke Street or to Keary Street via the hospital's lane.

The sidewalk will remain open on the north side of Allen Street.

Copperstone will still have access to its south parkade.
