### **Construction Notice for Neighbours**

# **Construction Update: June 11, 2018**

Here's an update on what's ahead, as a follow up to our previous notices and updates pertaining to excavation of roads surrounding Royal Columbian Hospital for a hospital IT and utilities pathway and for City power. Dates and times are subject to change.

#### **East Columbia Street**

Bird Construction has started the excavation on East Columbia Street which is now expected to last until mid to late July. Work happens in sections, proceeding from Sherbrooke Street to Keary Street in the northbound bike lane and east sidewalk. Drivers, bicyclists, pedestrians, and bus riders will be impacted.

#### Intersection of Sherbrooke Street and East Columbia

**Bird Construction indicates the excavation in the intersection is nearly complete** with only small intermittent excavations for water main commissioning left to do. Construction hours are 9am to 3pm Monday to Saturday.

### Sherbrooke Street (from East Columbia Street to just east of Fader St)

The timelines have been extended for the excavation on Sherbrooke Street between East Columbia Street to just east of Fader Street for multiple unanticipated reasons. Bird Construction now expects to have this work done by early July.

- The excavation near the corner of the east side of East Columbia Street is still underway.
- The spot excavation work near Fader and Kelly Street for water tie-ins is still upcoming. Neighbours impacted by short-term water shutoffs will be notified in advance.
- Sections of the sidewalks on the north side of the street will then be re-poured
- Some parking stalls on the south side of Sherbrooke Street will be used to store construction supplies and equipment while East Columbia Street is being excavated.

After Bird Construction finishes on Sherbrooke Street, Telus will then excavate the north lane of Sherbrooke Street to underground their cables. Telus will notify impacted neighbours. Paving and pole removal will happen at a later date.
