
# ROAD & SIDEWALK DISRUPTIONS during Phase One



Roads and sidewalks along the hospital's perimeter will be disrupted for installation of a hospital IT/utilities pathway and for city utilities, or for construction related to the new mental health facility

Stage 1: mid-Apr 2017 to early 2020
The west half of Allen St. will close to all traffic for excavation, and then installation of construction trailers. The north sidewalk will remain open, but may be disrupted at times

## Stage 2: October 2018 (date change)

The east half of Allen St. will close to traffic one lane at a time for underground utility work. Access to Copperstone's parkade will be maintained. The sidewalk will remain open but may be disrupted at times

#### Stage 3: May to June 2017

The City will excavate one lane at a time along Sherbrooke St. for storm sewer upgrades which will impact neighbouring streets

#### Stage 4: May to Nov 2017

The northern part of the hospital's private service lane from Sherbrooke to Allen St. will close to public traffic. The east sidewalk will close and vegetation may be removed, then replaced. Access for hospital deliveries will be maintained

### Stage 5: Summer/Fall 2018

This portion of Keary St. will have one lane at a time closed for water/ sewer excavation. Sidewalks may be impacted

# **Stage 6: Nov 2017 to early 2020**

The southern part of the hospital's private service lane from Allen St. to Keary St. will close to public traffic and pedestrians

# Stage 7: All of 2018

One lane of traffic and sidewalks will close in ~100m sections. Parking along the open lane may be temporarily closed in ~100m sections too. Access to the hospital and Emergency entry/exits and parking lots/ parkades will be maintained

# Stage 8: Summer 2018

Sherbrooke St. will be impacted by Telus for underground cabling. Parking and sidewalks may be disrupted. Telephone poles on the north side will be removed at a later date.

# Stage 9: Summer or Fall 2018

The City MAY upgrade a water main valve at Brunette and Keary.

COMPLETED. Our project MAY relocate overhead hydro lines. This would disrupt one lane of traffic at a time and possibly sidewalks
