Construction update



We are making great progress on both the interior and exterior of the Jim Pattison Acute Care Tower. Work is underway on all floors and our construction partner, EllisDon, is installing the new modular heliport on the roof. They are also installing a new retaining wall with a sidewalk to create a multi-use path by the hospital service lane. The sidewalk on the east side of the hospital will be closed until late November 2023. Thanks for your patience during this work. Read more.


Respecting our neighbourhood





Over the summer, EllisDon set up some additional areas for construction workers to take their breaks on site rather than in the neighbourhood. They also have full-time cleaners who check Sherbrooke Street every day for any debris left behind by workers. EllisDon regularly reminds workers not to park within one kilometre of the hospital and has their security company patrol the area to check for construction worker vehicles.
