#### Second dose COVID-19 vaccine clinic booking

- Staff, medical staff and essential visitors are eligible for their second dose, 42 days or later following their first dose. Vaccination appointments are continuously being added to the booking system, so they may need to check back for more clinic dates and times.
- To book an appointment, they need to go to <u>fraserhealth.ca/vaccinebooking</u>. They **must** use **Google Chrome web browser** for the form to work. The access code is Ocean.
- If they've forgotten the date of their first dose, they can access the date by registering at <u>healthgateway.gov.bc.ca</u>, using their BC Services Card;
- If they need help using the COVID-19 Vaccine Staff Booking Form at <u>fraserhealth.ca/vaccinebooking</u>, they can refer to the updated <u>Booking a COVID-19 Vaccine Appointment guide</u> for support.
