Low barrier pathway introduction to a rewarding career in healthcare

Address long-standing staffing challenges

New employer-supported training model

Health Care Support Worker



HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

- The HCSW holds temporary, full time interim status while completing workplace orientation, workplace learning and education and training requirements for a Health Care Aide (HCA) role.
- HCSWs are enrolled in a BC HCA Registry Accredited Health Care Aide Program. Program costs are funded directly to participating post secondary institutions. Salary and Stipend costs are provided to the employer to administer.
- Upon completion, HCSW is qualified for HCA roles, fulfilling a return of service agreement, on completion of their training, and registered with the BC Care Aide & Community Health Worker Registry.

HCAP

 Within the province ~12,000 individuals submitted their Expression of Interest for HCAP

Approximately 33% reside within the Fraser region

~300 HCSWs hired across the province

~66 HCSWs hired within Fraser region



MINISTRY OF HEALTH DIRECTIVE

...following <u>directives</u> and <u>accountabilities</u>...sufficient clarity on <u>implementation</u> in order to <u>support</u> all employers in their geographic areas to <u>expedite the hiring process</u> and identify <u>HCSWs</u> for each of the post-secondary institution cohorts...
