UPDATE Revision to Communal Dining in Respiratory Illness (RI) Toolkit

- Revision to the Influenza Outbreak Checklist, page 94, under the section "Additional Control Measures".
 - Upon review of the Influenza Outbreak Checklist with the Medical Health Officer, the following has been re-added to the checklist for clarity and consistency. The following is applicable if there is ONLY an influenza outbreak detected in the Care Home. Communal Dining on the affected unit(s) can continue with well, unaffected residents ensuring appropriate infection control measures are being followed (e.g. physical distancing, staggered meal times, hand hygiene, enhanced cleaning)
 - If additional pathogens have been identified, Care Homes are to follow the checklist with the stricter measures and consult PH.

 - When providing care to residents on CPAP/BiPAP in LTC, follow "Low Risk Category" of AGPs for residents on routine practices and no respiratory symptoms.
 - Follow "High Risk Category" during Enhanced monitoring, outbreaks and when residents are on droplet precautions.
