

N95 Respirator Fit-Tester Training Sessions

What's happening?

Fraser Health offering additional N95 fit-tester trainer sessions for Fraser Health affiliated long-term care and assisted living care communities. These sessions are being offered in order to ensure each care community can provide ongoing fit testing to team members as required.

What sessions are available?

The Exposure Prevention team at Fraser Health is offering five respiratory N95 fit tester-training for care community designates. Due to the hands-on nature of the session, a **maximum of 8-12 participants at each session can be accommodated. Additional sessions may be offered based on need.**

Long-term care and assisted living care communities who do not have local fit-testers or require additional fit-testers to test team members locally are asked to register as per below. This training will provide local fit tester certification to participants.

This course is offered free of charge to Fraser Health affiliate staff only. If non-affiliate staff, students, volunteers, or medical staff would like to take the training, there is a fee of \$210/participant. This is outlined in the course information on learning hub.
