Licensed Practical Nurse in Long Term Care and Assisted Living Self-Assessment Competency Tool

The Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) in Long Term Care (LTC) and Assisted Living (AL) Self-Assessment Competency Tool has been revised.

- This tool replaces the former CAPE tool "Licensed Practical Nurse Competency Document Residential Care"
- Licensed Practical Nurse Self Assessment Competency Tool lists competencies, indicators and ways of learning for each of the nine standard categories. These competencies are expectations of practice for the LPN in Long Term Care and Assisted Living.

How This May Affect You?

- The competencies, indicators and ways of learning support LPN learners and educators by identifying competencies that are foundational, intermediate and advanced as well as ways of learning to reach these.
- **For educators:** use the ways of learning to guide learners to develop their practice. There may be additional site-specific resources to reference for the LPN leaners.
- For LPN learners: use the tool to reflect on your practice and develop a
 collaborative professional development plan in consultation with your
 clinical educator or mentor.
