# The Regional Immunization Outreach Team is expanding its services for specialized populations

### What's happening?

- Fraser Health's Regional Immunization Outreach Team is now providing immunizations to specialized populations in communities across Fraser Health, such as under-served and vulnerable populations. It has transitioned to the organization's Population and Public Health department.
- You will receive the same support that you have been receiving for COVID immunizations.
- The ordering process for vaccine and immunization support is described below.
- The team is committed to providing outreach clinics in community locations, for populations identified as priorities by its partners and communities.

### How does this affect you?

- To order vaccines, use a new form: <a href="https://FHObservatory.checkbox.ca/PPH-Vaccine-Requests">https://FHObservatory.checkbox.ca/PPH-Vaccine-Requests</a>
  - Choose "SPRI" as the vaccine request type.
- Please note that 48 hours' notice is required for all vaccine and outreach orders.
- Indicate on the form if immunization support is required.
- Vaccines will be available for pick up at most public health units using an updated process.
- Vaccine deliveries will only be available in special circumstances. Add a note when you complete the order form if you are requesting a delivery.
