REMINDER Staff Screening COVID-19 Guidelines LTC-AL

- All care communities should be following staff guidelines for staff screening which is applicable to staff and medical staff in both owned and operated, and affiliated.
- All staff and medical staff will be actively screened upon entry. Active screening is defined as assigned
 personnel, screener or staff member, asking COVID-19 screening questions to everyone entering the
 facility or unit as stated on bottom of page 3 of <u>Fraser Health COVID-19 Staff and Medical Staff Screening
 Guidelines</u> (attached).
- Staff are only required to complete rapid test if symptomatic.
- Staff experiencing mild symptoms (e.g., sniffles, scratchy throat, headache) will receive rapid point of care
 test at work site prior to beginning work that day or if they develop symptoms while at work. Please see as
 stated on page 1 under Guidelines of the <u>Fraser Health COVID-19 Staff and Medical Staff Screening</u>
 Guidelines.
- Please see <u>BCCDC Guidelines Visitors in Long-Term Care and Seniors Assisted Living</u> on page 2, which
 outlines visitor screening guidelines. Visitor restrictions do not apply to health professionals, inspections
 staff or any outside providers (e.g., medical practitioners, home support workers, allied health-care
 providers) entering the care community to support residents.

REMINDER LTC/AL transitioning from the COVID-19 Toolkit to Respiratory Illness (RI) Toolkit
