## To Participate as Participants

Who can participate?

- Seniors 65+ with fluency in English and
  - o Living in the Fraser Health Region
  - o Concerned about becoming frail
  - o Have one or more chronic health conditions
  - o Able to give consent
  - o Have access to computer, internet, and a telephone
  - O Willing to commit to being in the study for 5 months

## To Volunteer as Health Coaches

Health coaches will:

- Receive training
- Not Needed to be residing in the Fraser Health Region
- Be paired with a study participant
- Provide a 45-minute weekly telephone call for 13 weeks
- Provide support, encouragement, and empower the participants towards health enhancing actions.
