### \*REMINDER\* \*Ministry of Health Reporting\*

- A reminder that the Ministry of Health is continuing to require all Health Authorities to report all active COVID positive LTC residents (on isolation still) and LTC Staff (not returned to work) for all FH LTC Owned and Operated and Affiliated LTC (funded) sites only. Campuses of care are asked to provide the data for LTC residents and staff only.
- Please continue to complete the survey in checkbox by 10:00 a.m. and report the cumulative numbers from the previous day/weekend at link below.
- Daily Ministry of Health Reporting: LTC Active COVID-19 Cases Survey

#### \*UPDATE\* \*Visitation Table\*

- Extended the designated visitor category to AL.
- Rapid testing for visitors in LTC remains a requirement, including for social visitors.
- Rapid testing may be done onsite or at home prior to visiting (within 48hours of visit).
- Masking in common areas still required but fully vaccinated visitor can remove their mask in single resident rooms.
